

YOUR UMF TRANSFER CHECKLIST

FALL 2023

After you are accepted to Farmington (We've said "Yes" to you)

- Say Yes to UMF!** Submit the enrollment deposit and the Admission Reply Form to **confirm your spot in the class**. Earlier confirmation results in the best class selection!
- accounts.maine.edu Set up your personal **MaineStreet portal**. You will need your Student ID number, username, and activation code (sent to you by email after you applied).
- gmail.maine.edu Check your **"maine.edu" email**, or forward it to another email that you do check. It is how we will communicate with you.
- fafsa.gov File the **2023-2024 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)**. (UMF code is 002040).
- mainestreet.maine.edu Check your MaineStreet portal for **financial aid updates** and other items on your "To Do" list in the Student Self-Service Center.

After you Confirm (You've said "Yes" to UMF)

- mycampus.umf.maine.edu **Visit myCampus**, your Farmington specific portal with a "New Student" section just for you. Use your MaineStreet username and password to sign in.
- Submit immunization records (measles, mumps, etc.) by January 1st (for students entering spring semester) or by mid-summer (for students entering fall semester).
- If you are planning to live on campus, complete the **Housing Application** and **Room and Board License**. Questions? Contact Housing at 207.778.7488.
- Complete the **Financial Terms and Conditions Agreement** located on your "To Do" list in MaineStreet. This must be done before you can be registered for classes.
- An advisor from your academic program will contact you to **set up your class schedule**.
- Review and **accept your financial aid awards** on MaineStreet.
- Make sure your academic transcripts have been sent for all college coursework completed, including Dual Enrollment classes, Early College classes, and AP exam results. These must be requested by you and sent directly to the Shared Processing Center, PO Box 412, Bangor, ME 04402.
