## FALL 2025 - Nursing: First Year & Transfer

### After you are accepted to Farmington (We've said "Yes" to you)

- [farmington.edu/accepted](https://farmington.edu/accepted) Say Yes to UMF! Submit the enrollment deposit and the Admission Reply Form to **confirm your spot in the class.**
- [accounts.maine.edu](https://accounts.maine.edu) Set up your personal **MaineStreet portal**. You will need your Student ID number, username, and activation code (enclosed in this packet).
- [gmail.maine.edu](https://gmail.maine.edu) Check your **"maine.edu" email**, or forward it to another email that you do check. We will be sending important information to your "maine.edu" email address.
- [fafsa.gov](https://fafsa.gov) **File the 2025-2026 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) when it's available** (code 002040).
- [mainestreet.maine.edu](https://mainestreet.maine.edu) Check your MaineStreet portal for **financial aid updates** and other items on your **"ToDo"** list in the Student Self-Service Center.

### After you Confirm (You've said "Yes" to UMF)

- 1** [mycampus.umf.maine.edu](https://mycampus.umf.maine.edu) **Visit my Campus**, your Farmington specific portal with a "new Student" section just for you. Use your MaineStreet username and password to sign in.
- 2** If you are planning on living on campus, complete the **Housing Application & Room and Board License**. These can be accessed on myCampus in April. Questions should be directed to Housing at 207.778.7488
- 3** Complete the **Financial Terms and Conditions Agreement**, located on your "To Do" list in MaineStreet. This must be done before you can be registered for classes. Review and **accept your financial aid awards**.
- 4** Connect with and advisor from your academic program to set up your class schedule.
- 5** Review and accept your financial aid awards!
- 6** Make sure your final High School transcript and other academic transcripts have been sent, including Dual enrollment classes, Early College, and AP exam results. For transfer students, please send any final college transcripts when available. These must be requested by you and sent directly to the Shared Processing Center, PO Box 412, Bangor, ME 04402.
- 7** Submit your immunization records: [farmington.edu/student health](https://farmington.edu/student-health)
- 8** Watch for an email from the University of Maine System on how to submit a photo for your UMF ID Card.
